



Barnards Farm is located in West Horndon, Essex. It is open to the public as part of the National Gardens Scheme and all proceeds from open days are donated to charity. Barnard Farm has 17 hectares of land and has a variety of gardens; it also has a small motor vehicle museum and 1920's cycle shop which is open to visitors on Sundays.

In the small motor vehicle museum Richco were advised that the flooring area required re-surfacing. The area of floor measured 225 square metres, however the existing floor was made up from various different floor levels where previous walls had been removed which had caused movement within the original floor surface.

The Richco application team carried out the floor preparation to the entire surface using our specialist vacuum assisted floor equipment and carried out any flooring repairs required.

Once the floor had been fully prepared and primed, Richco application team then applied Richco Liquid Vinyl in grey with a decorative PVA flake.

Richco Liquid Vinyl is a heavy duty self levelling system which gives excellent resistance to abrasion and chemical attack whilst providing a seamless finish.

This material was recommended due to the flexible nature of this product and the issue of the movement on this particular floor. The introduction of the PVA flake also provides a decorative anti-slip finish.

The finished floor met with the client's requirements by providing a seamless, hardwearing flooring system.
